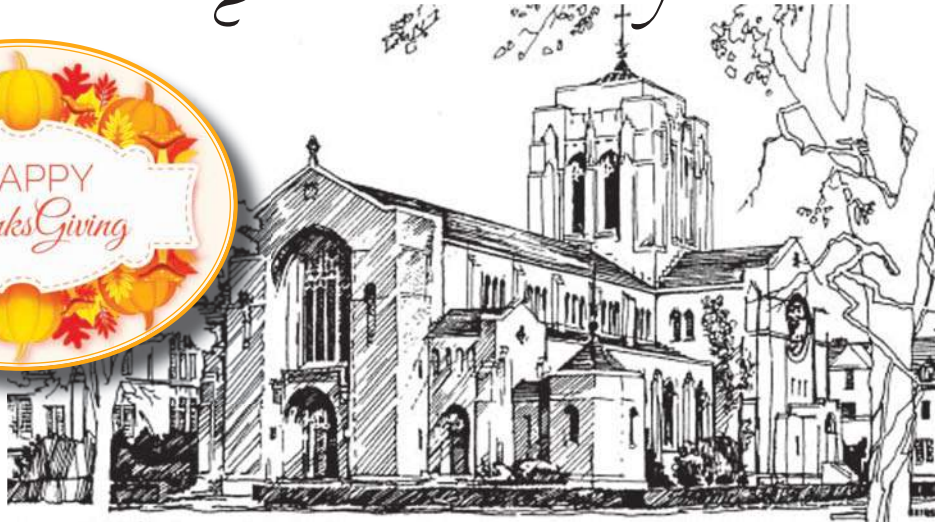

#### CATHOLIC CAMPAIGN FOR HUMAN DEVELOPMENT WORKING ON THE MARGINS

The annual collection for the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) is also being taken today. From this collection, 25 percent of funds remain in our Diocese to support local anti-poverty programs. This past year CCHD supported seven groups in Brooklyn and Queens in their struggles to break the cycle of poverty: the Milk Not Jails project; East River Development Alliance (credit union for low-income residents of Queens); Brandworkers Int'l (aid for local food workers); Working World Inc. 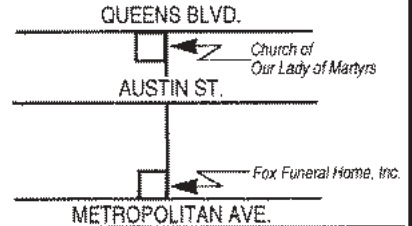
