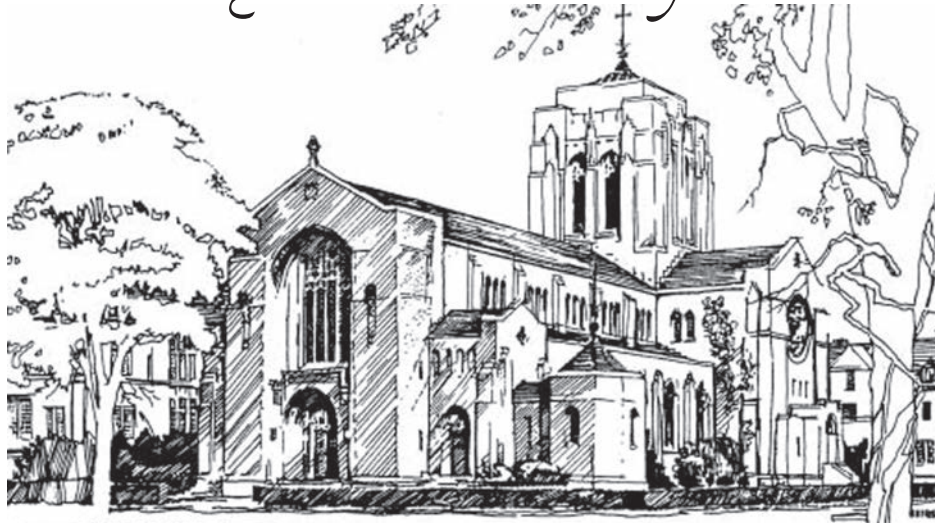

RCIA Welcoming

Next week on the second Sunday of Advent (December 6) at the 11:30 a.m. liturgy our parish will welcome all those individuals who are preparing to fully join the Catholic Church at the Easter Vigil. Please keep our candidates in your prayers as they continue on their journey of faith.

The Meaning of the Advent Wreath

Advent is a time of joyful hope before the coming of Christ at Christmas. The Advent wreath is one of the most recognized customs. The circular evergreen wreath symbolizes the world—which belongs to Christ. The ribbons knotted to the wreath remind us that we, too, belong to Christ. The candles represent the four weeks of Advent. According to tradition, three of the candles are violet and the fourth is rose. One candle is lit each week, and the rose candle is lit on the third Sunday of Advent. Our church (and some families, too) will light a fifth candle, a white one, on Christmas Day.

When the Advent wreath is used in church, on the second and succeeding Sundays of Advent the candles are lit either before Mass begins or immediately before the opening prayer. When the Advent wreath is used in the home, families may share a meal, sing an Advent hymn or read from Scripture before or after the candles are lit.

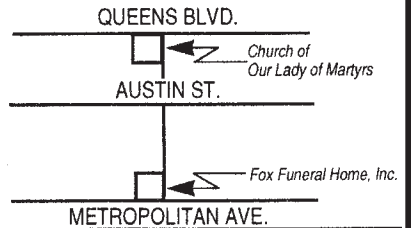
