Depart New York JFK International Airport for Rome. (Group airfare to be advised–subject to confirmation upon group materialization).

### DAY 2 <u>Tuesday, September 2: Welcome to Rome!</u>

Arrive at Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport, proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way Tours tour manager upon our exit from Customs. (One group airport transfer time will be advised). Our luggage will be transferred to a comfortable. touring bus, and we will be on our way to Trastevere, a popular neighborhood known for its great restaurants and pubs. **Celebrate Mass at the Basilica of Santa Maria in Trastevere.** After Mass, we'll

### have an independent lunch in the area.

Check in at the Cardinal Hotel. Free afternoon to enjoy Rome on your own.

Dinner and overnight at the Cardinal Hotel in Rome. (D)

### DAY 3 <u>Wednesday, September 3: Papal Audience</u>

# Early breakfast at our hotel. Enter the heart of Christendom for a general audience with Pope Leo XIV. The Holy Father will greet the pilgrims, deliver his message, pray the Pater Noster, and bless religious articles. Independent lunch.

This afternoon we will have an unique tour of Rome and her outskirts. Drive past Tiberina Island, Aventine Hill, the pyramid of Caius Cestius, and St. Paul's Gate, part of the ancient Aurelian Wall. Visit the Catacombs of St. Domitilla, the maze of tunnels hollowed out of volcanic rock where early Christians secretly practiced their religious rites and buried their dead. **Celebrate Mass in the Catacombs.** 

Independent dinner. Overnight at the Cardinal Hotel in Rome. (B)

### DAY 4 <u>Thursday</u>, <u>September 4: Holy Doors of St. Peter's</u> <u>Basilica | Vatican Museums | Sistine Chapel | Papal Basilicas of</u> Rome

After an early breakfast, we will be transferred to St. Peter's Basilica. Enter through the Holy Door to receive a plenary indulgence. Celebrate Mass at the Tomb of St. Peter (*subject to confirmation*) or one of the Grotto Chapels. After Mass, take in the awesome architecture and the statuary adorning this largest of all Christian churches, including Michelangelo's magnificent "Pieta." Pray at the tomb of St. John Paul II in St. Sebastian's Chapel. Then, we'll visit one of the great art collections in the world, the Vatican Museums. Walk through the Sistine Chapel and see the frescoes of numerous Renaissance masters and the inspired ceiling of Michelangelo. Independent lunch.

Continue our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Mary Major, one of the four major basilicas built by Pope Sixtus III (432-440 A.D.). View the impressive interior with its remarkable mosaics depicting scenes from the Old Testament. Pray near the relics of Jesus' manger from Bethlehem. View the icon Salus Populi Romani, believed to be painted by St. Luke, and continue to the new tomb of Pope Francis where we will pause to pray. The mosaics above the entablature are among the most ancient Christian mosaics in Rome. Continue to the Cathedral of St. John Lateran, the first Christian church to be consecrated. It was founded by Emperor Constantine in the 4th century and home to popes for many years prior to the present Vatican residence. From there, we'll pass the Holy Stairs, said to be the steps on which Christ walked on His way to Pilate's palace. You can go up on your knees as thousands of pilgrims have done in reverently recalling the sufferings of Christ. Then, we will visit the Basilica of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem, which houses fragments of the true cross brought to Rome by St. Helena, mother of Constantine.

### DAY 5 <u>Friday, September 5: Optional Excursion to Assisi</u> Optional Excursion (Additional cost to be advised)

Breakfast at our hotel. Depart Rome for our full-day excursion to Assisi, one of the high points of any travel experience. After a two-hour ride, we will see Assisi on a mountaintop, with its narrow lanes, Shrines of St. Francis, and art dedicated to its young friar, a rich young man who

turned to God after an illness and established an order that has grown stronger over the centuries. Arrive in time to **celebrate 11:00 a.m. Mass at the Basilica of St. Francis.** After Mass, our local guide will take us to explore the basilica complex, which is actually composed of two churches built one atop the other. Beneath both churches is the crypt that houses the tomb of St. Francis. The lower basilica dates from 1228 to 1230 and is richly decorated with beautiful stained-glass windows and paintings by some of the most important artists of the 13th and 14th centuries. In the upper basilica, built from 1230 to 1253, we will marvel at the monumental frescoes painted by Giotto, which depict scenes from the life of the saint. Continue to visit the Basilica of St. Clare, the first and most important heroine of the Franciscan movement. We'll view her remains and see the basilica's miraculous crucifix. Independent lunch in Assisi.

We'll walk to the Sanctuary of the Renunciation, a part of the Church of St. Mary Major. Pray near the tomb of Blessed Carlo Acutis, the young Catholic from Italy who had a passionate devotion to the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. His tomb is in a sanctuary located on the spot where a young St. Francis of Assisi is said to have cast off his rich clothes in favor of a poor habit. Continue to visit the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli, a great basilica built in 1569 and crowned by Alessi's magnificent dome. It encloses the shrine of the "Porziuncula," or the Little Portion Chapel, around which the first Franciscan community was centered; the place where Clare received the habit from Francis; and the Capella Del Transito, which marks the spot where the Saint died. You will see the statue of Saint Francis in the courtyard where thornless roses bloom. A stop will be made en route back to Rome for an independent dinner and refreshments. Overnight at the Cardinal Hotel in Rome. (B)

### DAY 6 Saturday, September 6: Free Day in Rome

Breakfast at our hotel. Free day to enjoy Rome on your own. Overnight at the Cardinal Hotel in Rome.

### DAY 7 <u>Sunday, September 7: Canonization of Blessed Carlo</u> <u>Acutis and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati | St. Paul Outside-the-</u> <u>Walls | Farewell Dinner</u>

After an early breakfast, we'll be transferred to a drop off point from which we will walk to St. Peter's Square to attend the **Canonization Mass of Blessed Carlo Acutis and Blessed Pier Giorgio Frassati, celebrated by Pope Leo XIV.** Independent lunch.

Continue our day with a visit to the Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls, built by Constantine in the 4th century. St. Paul is buried in the confessio of this church. Above his tomb are the chains that were used to imprison him prior to hhis martyrdom. These chains were placed in this prominent location in 2008. The main altar in the left transept is dedicated to the Conversion of St. Paul. The painting above this altar, completed by Vincenzo Camuccini, depicts this event. See the tabernacle of the confession by Arnolfo di Cambio, an exquisite 12thcentury candelabra by Vassalletto, a 13th-century Byzantine-style apse mosaic of Christ Pantocrator, and an attractive 19th-century series of Papal Portraits in a frieze extending around the nave. Then, drive along a section of the Old Appian Way, one of the first ancient Roman military roads that connected Rome to Naples and Brindisi on the Adriatic coast.

### **Our farewell dinner will be at Scarpone Restaurant in Rome.** Experience an atmosphere of hospitality and friendship, and taste wonderful Mediterranean cuisine in a typical Roman setting.

### DAY 8 Monday, September 8: Return to the USA

After breakfast, we will be transferred to Rome's Leonardo da Vinci Airport for our return flight to the USA. (B)

This pilgrimage entails a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc. Participants must be medically and physically fit for this type of travel. Package inclusions do not always meet the special needs of travelers with limited mobility or severe allergies. If you have concerns or health issues, please discuss with Peter's Way Tours before enrolling in the pilgrimage.

#### Acceptance of these <u>Terms & Conditions</u>, with signature on enrollment form, is required for participation in this tour.

PAYMENT: All payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or at the end of the tour. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are. debit/credit card. Peter's Way Tours (PWT) reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: \$500.00 of the tour payment is non-refundable upon receipt. If you cancel after July 15, all payments are non-refundable, including departure taxes & fuel surcharges, single supplement, deviation fees, travel insurance payments, or other costs. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements. U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in late 2026, visitors to the European Union may require additional travel documents to enter the EU. Once this program is launched, PWT will be sent information to apply online for an ETIAS prior to travel (if required). Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (ie., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package does not include airfare. Group airfare is subject to confirmation upon group materialization. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing. All flights are booked under one itinerary. If a traveler does not travel on any one of the flights in the proper sequence, the rest of the reservation will be automatically canceled by the airline. Rebooking the canceled flight would be subject to a change fee and possible fare difference. If you purchase independent flights, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost(s) if you cancel participation for any reason. It is important that you do not purchase airline tickets until the group has been confirmed for travel by PWT.

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: The Land Only package price is \$2,750.00 per person sharing a twin room (\$150 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check). The Land Only package does not include group airfare. It is the traveler's responsibility to book airline tickets independently. Any tour participant may change their status to "Land Only" by notifying PWT in writing, up to 100 days prior to departure. Passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package, or deviating from the group itinerary, are responsible for their own transfers to/from the hotel/airport. However, if your flights coordinate with the groups' arrangements, you are welcome to utilize the group transfer(s). If you purchase your own airline transportation and the group does not materialize or you cancel for any reason, PWT will not be held responsible for the cost of your airfare.

DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: PWT is pleased to assist clients with special requests. Deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 100 days prior to departure. A deviation fee of \$150 plus any increase in airfare or additional fees may also apply. Not all carriers permit routing changes and/or deviations from the group itinerary. Please contact PWT for more information.

TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: One overseas round-trip airport transfer will be provided (time to be advised). Porterage of one piece of luggage at hotels throughout your tour is included. Peter's Way Tours cannot be held liable for any misplaced or lost luggage. It is the passenger's responsibility to make sure their luggage travels with them the entirety of the trip.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Married couples may request a double bed which is subject to availability. Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$1,095.00 will apply. We cannot guarantee roommate requests but will make every effort to pair you with another traveler, if double occupancy is requested. If a single room must be assigned due to lack of a traveler to pair you with, a roommate's cancellation, incompatibility, or any other reason (at the last moment or while on tour), you will be charged the single supplement.

MEALS: Breakfast daily, plus welcome and farewell dinner at a restaurant in Rome.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. Although voluntary, for good work we recommend \$8.00 per person per day for your tour manager; \$5.00 per person per day for your bus driver; and \$2.00 per tour for local guides. Tips for your tour manager and bus driver are normally given as a group

included in the package price. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave \$1.00 per person for the wait staff after each meal and \$1.00 per person pe day for housekeeping. (For tips, USD is accepted however local currency is preferred). TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: Passengers must be medically and physically fit for travel and ensure that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others. Most pilgrimages entail a lot of walking, stairs, hills, cobblestone roads, etc. Tour buses are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. A traveler who requires special assistance must notify PWT and must be accompanied by a travel companion who will provide proper help. PWT shall not be held responsible if we are unable to accommodate passengers with special needs, or for the denial of services to a passenger by any carrier, hotel, restaurant, or other independent suppliers.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: It is strongly recommended that all participants purchase insurance when they travel since the tour operator is not responsible for nonrefundable payments, damaged luggage, or trip interruption. PWT offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan. These benefits and services help ensure the wellbeing of the passenger while traveling worldwide. The insurance premium is based on total package price, including taxes, fuel surcharges, single supplements, deviation fees, late charges, etc (see chart below). If the insurance premium is included with your deposit, the passenger will be covered for pre-existing conditions.
