Of all things visible and invisible.

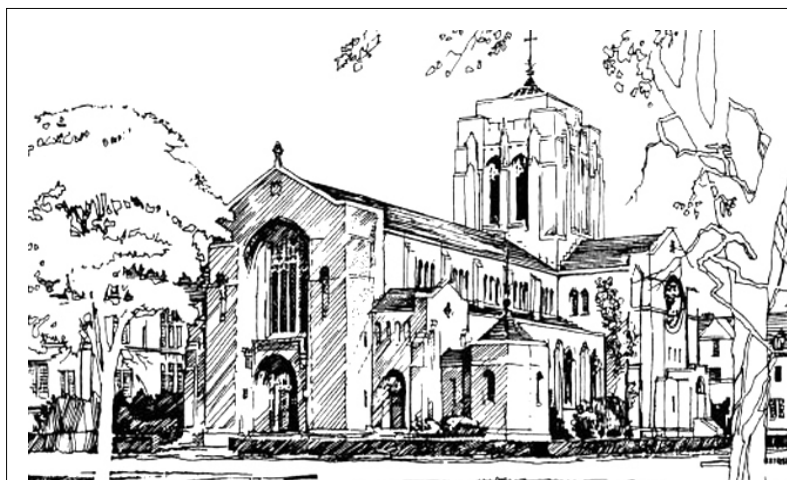
I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ,
