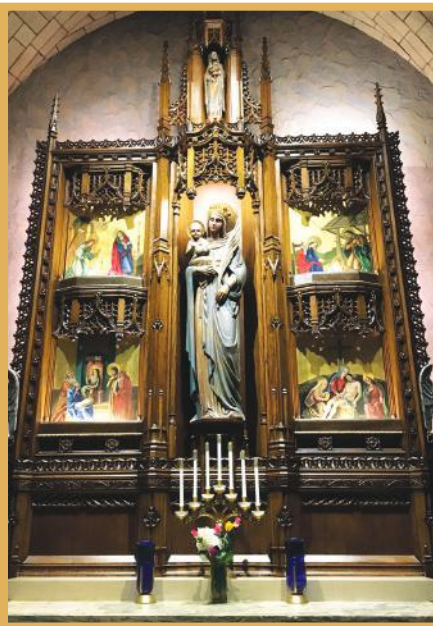
Time for School Already

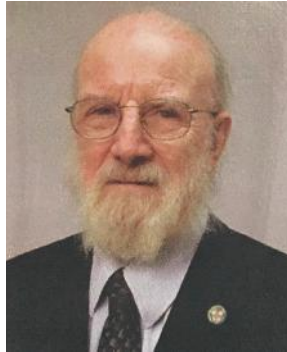

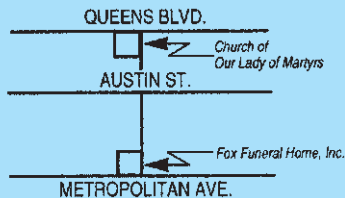
