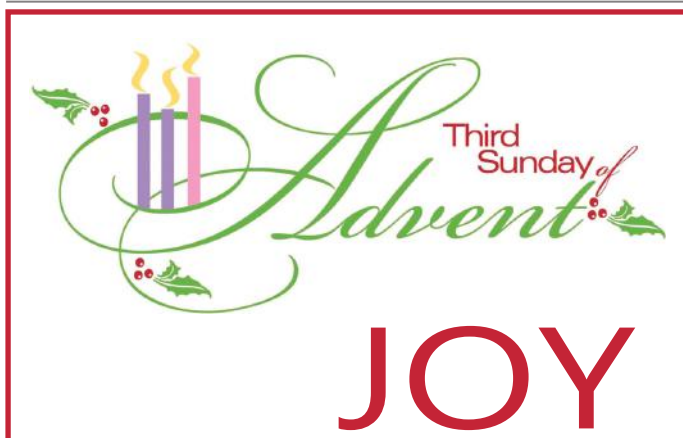

Message from Bishop Sanchez

Parish Planning for the Future

Bishop DiMarzio has authorized our Territorial Vicar, the Very. Rev. Thomas Pettei, and his assistant Ms. Ellen Rhatigan to give presentations on the topic of future planning to parish leaders in each deanery. Father Passenant accompanied a group of our parish leaders to our last deanery meeting on Thursday, November 29.

Among the statistics that were distributed at the meeting were the following:

- In 2006, there were 309 priests assigned to active parish ministry.
- In 2017, there were 273 priests assigned to active parish ministry, a 12 percent decrease.
- A large number of priests will retire in the next 5 to 10 years.
- There are currently 17 parishes with two worship sites and 4 parishes with three worship sites.
- There are currently 186 Catholic parishes in Brooklyn and Queens.

Among other items, there are two takeaways from the informational meeting. The first is the call to continue

to pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life. The second is to begin to think about the idea of parish partnerships. Such partnerships would encourage the sharing of ministries, services, and resources between neighboring parishes.

One example of such sharing is seen in the support that our parish gives to the food pantries at Our Lady of Mercy and Our Lady of the Angelus. Instead of duplicating a third food pantry here, we contribute to the two neighboring food pantries that already exist.

Another example of such sharing is through the collaboration of Our Lady Queen of Martyrs and Our Lady of Mercy (OLM) in basketball, swimming, and track, assisted by the Catholic Youth Organization.

A third example of such sharing is seen in the collaboration between OLM and OLQM in the parish youth program. As we move forward, we hope that other ways of collaborating will develop.

Crisis in the Church

In last week's bulletin, I repeated Bishop DiMarzio's observation that no other comparable institution except the Catholic Church has been singled out by the New York State Attorney General's subpoena asking for information about any sexual abuse of minors and adults. The New York State approach to targeting only the Catholic Church unfairly creates two classes of victims—those abused in the Church and those abused in other institutions. It seems that the rights of those abused in other institutions are ignored.

The issue of abuse is painful and complex. A summary of the aspects of this crisis, in Q&A format, has been prepared by the bishop and his staff. In addition to the questions and answers, there is a video of his meetings with lay leaders throughout our diocese. Both the Q&A summary and the video link are available on our website. 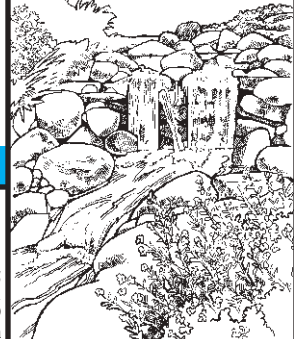

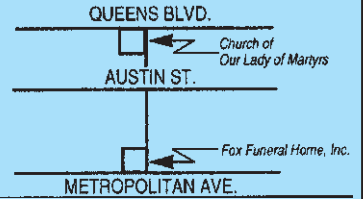
