Pray for All Victim-Survivors

As Roman Catholics, we have surely been disturbed by the negative press about the Catholic Church these past few months. I ask for your continued prayers for all victim-survivors.

Pray also for our Church. As Bishop DiMarzio reminded us in his recent column on the Roman Catholic dioceses of New York State, no other comparable institutions except our dioceses have been served with a subpoena by the State

Attorney General. The subpoena asks the dioceses in this state for a multiplicity of information regarding the sexual abuse of minors and adults by any clergy, employees, and volunteers of each diocese since 1950. My question is: If the state was truly concerned about all victim-survivors, why has it not subpoenaed all institutions that work with minors and vulnerable adults?—*Bishop Sanchez*

Census Sunday 2018 Results

Our Lady Queen of Martyrs conducted a Census on September 15 and 16, in an effort to increase parish registration as well as update current parishioner information. *Parish registration is the best way to certify parish membership. Registering at OLQM is a declaration of one's desire to be a part of our Catholic community and to make a commitment to the life of our parish.*

516 parishioners completed a census form. Here are some of the tabulated results:

- Many of our survey participants (over 20%) were not officially registered with our parish.
- OLQM's cultural and lingual composition remains as diverse as ever (note that a participant could choose more than one race or language). *It is this diversity that enables OLQM to continue having several special ethnic celebrations every year.*
- Of the participants who indicated that OLQM is their parish, 23% started worshipping here within the last five years; 18% of OLQM's parishioners have lived in the neighborhood no more than five years. *So, as the parish changes, pastoral needs are changing as well.*

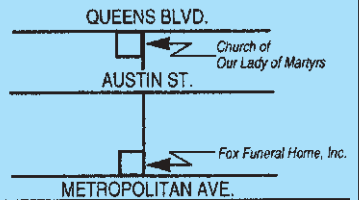
