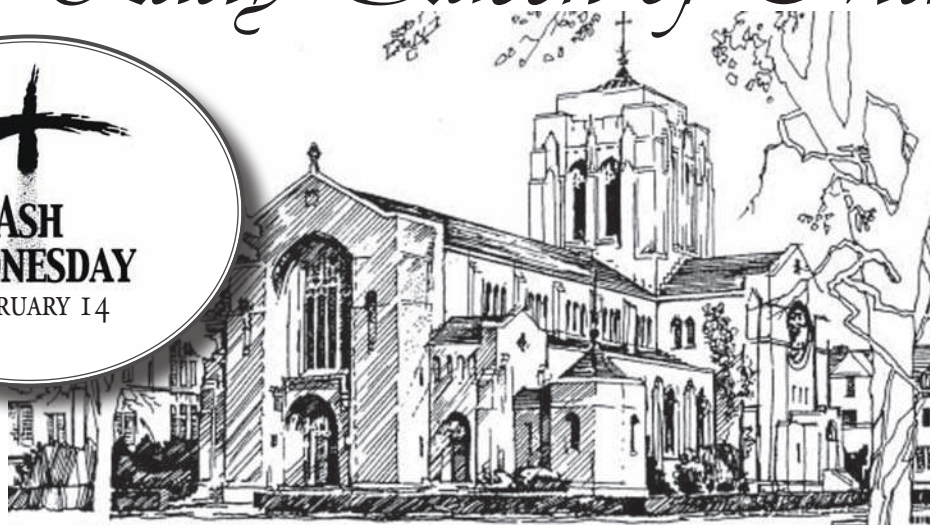

ALLELUIA SUNDAY

On this final Sunday in Ordinary Time before Lent, join us in singing "Alleluia! Alleluia" as the closing hymn. During Lent, which begins this Ash Wednesday, we begin fasting from using this acclamation. Why? The Church traditionally refrains from singing "Alleluia" during Lent and instead waits in anticipation of singing it again fully on Easter.

Lenten Regulations

During this time of spiritual renewal for Catholics, we observe prayer and penance. Please be mindful of the following this season of Lent 2018.

Abstinence: The Church asks all the faithful age 14 and older to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday (this year, February 14) and all Fridays of Lent.

Fasting: All the faithful ages 18 to 59 are obligated to fast on Ash Wednesday (February 14) and Good Friday (March 30). Limit yourself to a single full meal and two smaller ones during the day, with no food between meals.

No Dispensation for Ash Wednesday: There is no dispensation granted from fasting and abstinence on Ash Wednesday, despite its falling on Valentine’s Day this year. For Catholics wanting to have a Valentine’s celebration, please do so on the Tuesday before, a day traditionally associated with festive celebrations in advance of Lent.


Easter Duty: All Catholics who have been initiated into the Holy Eucharist are expected to receive Holy Communion at least once a year, between the First Sunday of Lent (February 18) and Trinity Sunday (May 27).

Reconciliation Monday: Members of the faithful are asked to confess once a year grave sins that have not already been absolved. The Monday of Holy Week (March 26) we offer an opportunity to participate in this great Sacrament of Healing with Confession hours in the morning, afternoon and evening.

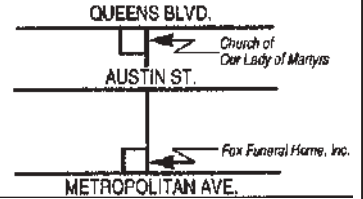
