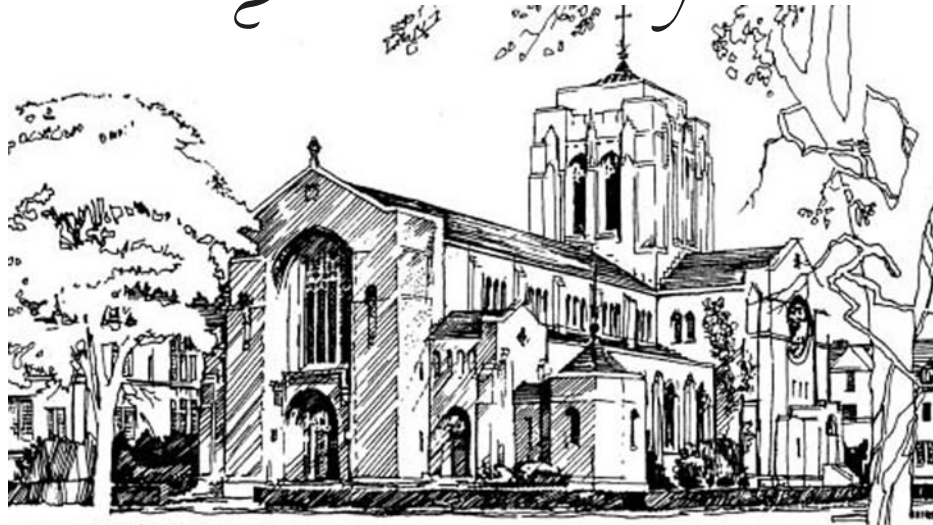

12:05 p.m. Mass on Saturday, February 10

Once a year, on or near the Church observance of the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes and the World Day of the Sick (February 11), our parish offers an opportunity for the reception of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Through anointing, a person obtains the benefit of divine grace. The anointing with oil of the sick is used to support those who seek healing. It is intended for those who have illness, are anticipating surgery, and the frail and elderly, and can be requested by anyone in need of healing of body, mind or spirit. 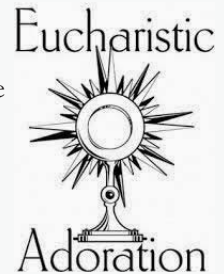

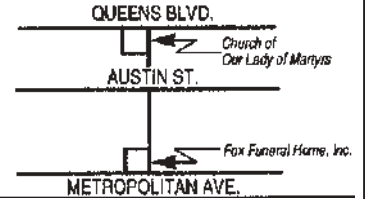

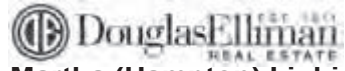
