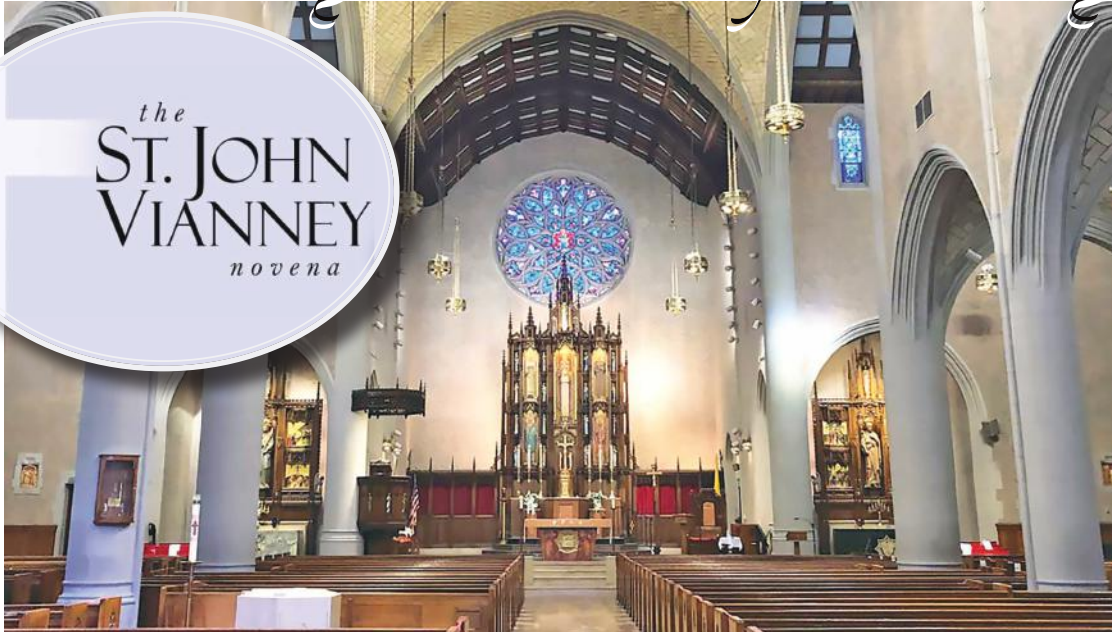

This Week's Reflection

from Catholic Social Teaching

Second Commandment

You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.

O LORD, our Lord, how awesome is your name through all the earth! (Psalm 8:2)

REFLECT: “Among all the words of Revelation, there is one which is unique: the revealed name of God. God confides his name to those who believe in him; he reveals himself to them in his personal mystery. The gift of a name belongs to the order of trust and intimacy.... For this reason, man must not abuse it. He must keep it in mind in silent, loving adoration. He will not introduce it into his own speech except to bless, praise, and glorify it.... The second commandment prescribes respect for the Lord's name....

“Hallowed Be Thy Name”: Beginning with this first petition to our Father, we are immersed in the innermost mystery of his Godhead and the drama of the salvation of our humanity. Asking the Father that his name be made holy draws us into his plan of loving kindness for the fullness of time, ‘according to his purpose which he set forth in Christ,’ that we might be holy and blameless before him in love....

“In making man in his image and likeness, God ‘crowned him with glory and honor,’ but by sinning, man fell ‘short of the glory of God.’ From that time on, God was to manifest his holiness by revealing and giving his name, in order to restore man to the image of his Creator.... In Jesus the name of the Holy God is revealed and given to us ... as Savior, revealed by what he is, by his word, and by his sacrifice.... Because he sanctifies his own name, Jesus reveals to us the name of the Father....

“We ask God to hallow his name, which by its own holiness saves and makes holy all creation.... But we ask that this name of God should be hallowed in us through our actions.” (Catechism of the Catholic Church).

ACT: Pray the Divine Praises.

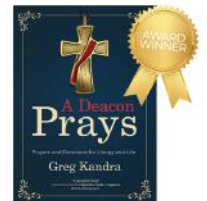

Father Andrew is presently assigned at St. Bartholomew parish in Elmhurst and is the first native-born Chinese American priest in the Diocese of Brooklyn.
