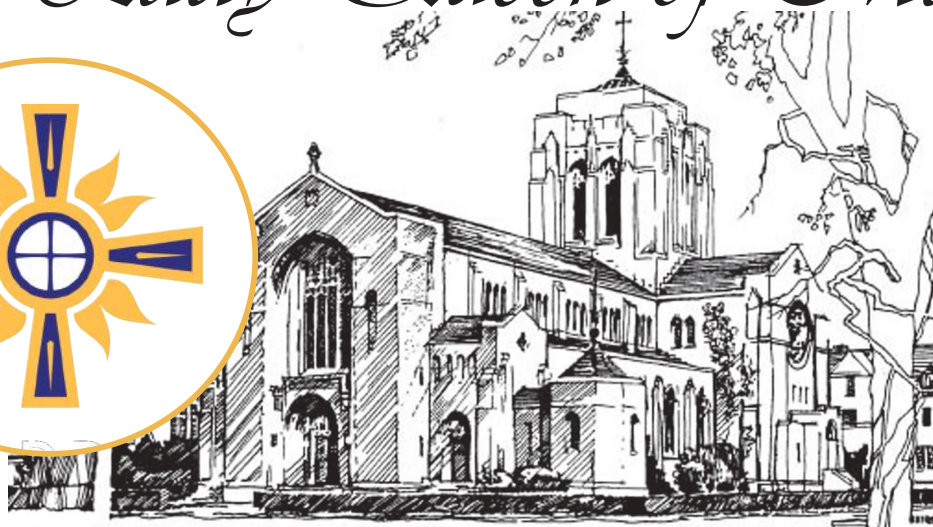

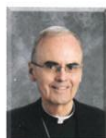
CORRECTION
