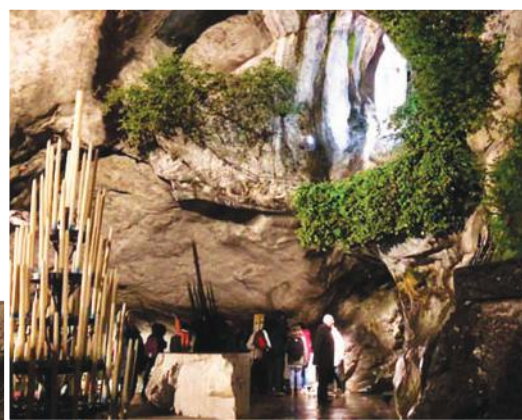
Prayers for May

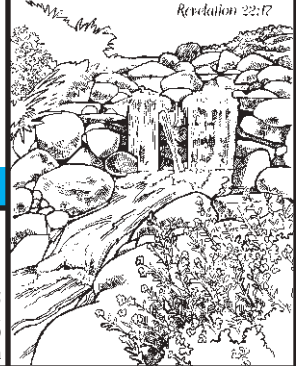

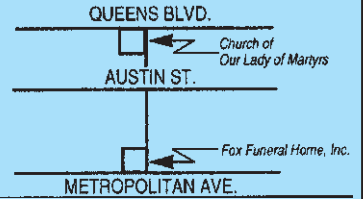
