## Fasting before Holy Communion

Present Church law states that Catholics are required to fast from food and drink (not water) for one hour before receiving Holy Communion. The law also states that this fast "may be reduced to 15 minutes for those who are sick or for other important reasons."

In the light of recent incidents in Church where people have fainted due to a sharp drop in blood sugar from fasting before Mass, we ask you to please use your own good judgment before coming to Mass by nourishing yourself properly. Thank you for your continued prayerful presence with us.

The Holy Eucharist is transported in a processional monstrance, carried by a priest and protected by an embroidered canopy held by an altar server. We ask members of our parish to join the procession to three altars, set up on our church grounds, as the choir sings sacred hymns. At each altar (convent, rectory steps, main doors to the church) the Blessed Sacrament rests while we kneel to pray and sing in adoration of the Holy Eucharist.

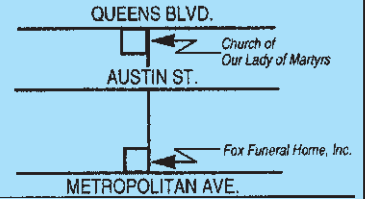
