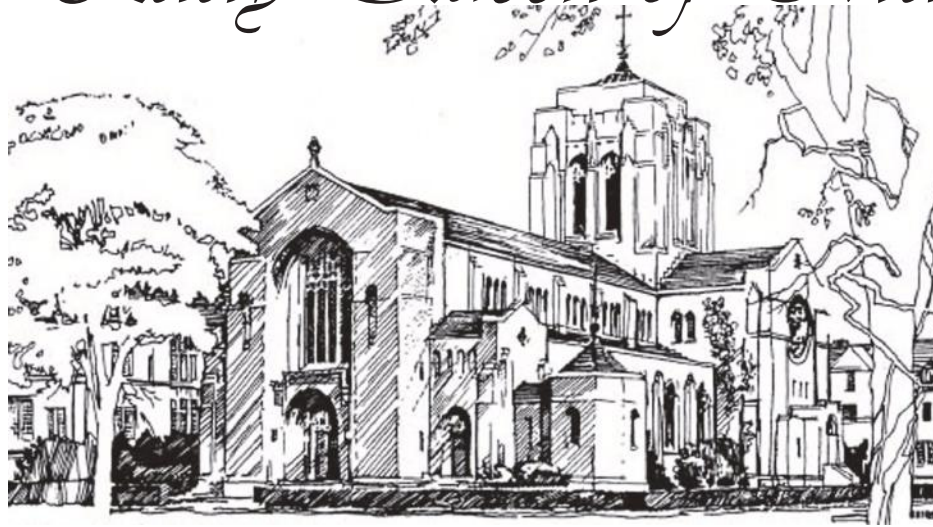

**A NOTE ABOUT FASTING BEFORE COMMUNION:** We appreciate that many of our elderly parishioners make an extra effort to attend services during the Thanksgiving and Christmas seasons. Many of you also observe the pious practice of fasting the night before. It has been our experience that some people may suffer ill effects from fasting before Mass, due to a sharp drop in blood sugar. We ask that you use good judgment before coming to Mass by nourishing yourself properly. Please consider the *Church's teaching on fasting before Holy Communion*, which is as follows: "Present Church law states that Catholics are required to fast from food and drink (not water) for one hour before receiving Holy Communion. The law also states that this fast 'may be reduced to 15 minutes for those who are sick or for other important reasons.'" Thank you for your continued prayerful presence with us.

Please bring your bags of nonperishable and canned foods to the front of the church and leave them by the altar rail.

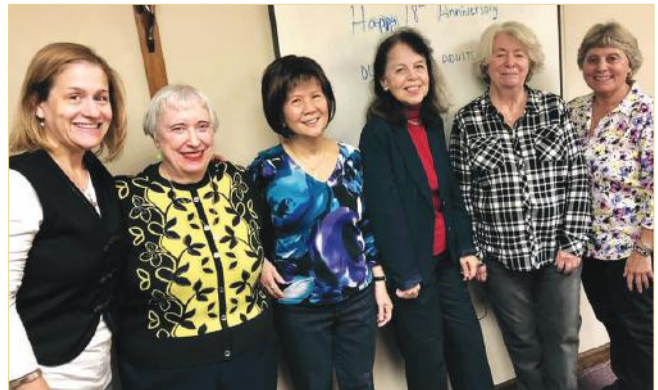

### RCIA at OLQM

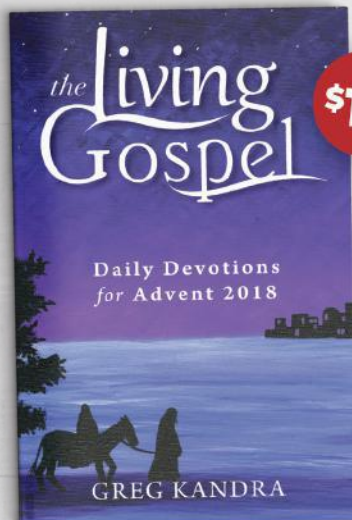

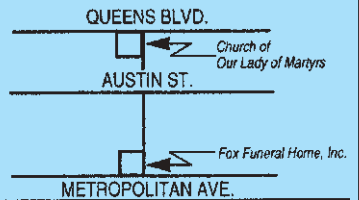
