Please consider the *Church's teaching on fasting before Holy Communion*, which is as follows: "Present Church law states that Catholics are required to fast from food and drink (not water) for one hour before receiving Holy Communion. The law also states that this fast 'may be reduced to 15 minutes for those who are sick or for other important reasons." Thank you for your continued prayerful presence with us.




