This extraordinary endeavor is designed to ensure the long term ability of the Church in Brooklyn and Queens to support our immediate priorities, launch new programs and address local needs in one coordinated effort within each parish.

Our parish target for this historic initiative is \$1,020,000. Fifty percent (50%) of the total funds we raise, less our Annual Catholic Appeal obligation for 2016, will remain with us for our own parish needs. If we surpass our target, we will then retain seventy-five percent (75%) of all funds raised above our goal. For every dollar over 125% of our goal, the parish will receive 100% of funds.


The Annual Catholic Appeal for 2016 is already included in the parish target which amounts to \$99,874.

If we are to continue our mission, the facilities and ministries of *Our Lady Queen of Martyrs* must be enhanced in order to meet the spiritual, physical and social needs of our parish community. The funds that we raise will enable us to enhance our ministries by completing the following projects:

CHURCH ORGAN REPLACEMENT:

\$285,000

Our present Church Organ is beyond practical repair. The digital format of this new Church Organ is cost effective that will allow for additional components and future upgrades which will extend the life of the new instrument.

SANCTUARY WOODWORK RENEWAL:

\$40,000

It has been pointed out to us that the sanctuary and side altar wood carvings need to be cleaned and varnished. These beautifully carved appointments provide the backdrop for our worship environment. This time consuming project needs to be done before they deteriorate into a state of disrepair.

CEMENT UPGRADES:


\$120,000

The funds received from this campaign will allow us to accomplish further work towards the completion of the Cement Replacement Program begun in 2014 with attention to 72nd Road, the length of the block, the front of the Church as well as the interior sidewalks of the Parish Campus. This portion of the Cement Replacement Program will cost \$120,000

CHURCH FLOOR:

\$20,000

We recently completed, thanks to the proceeds received from the past Parish Galas and Church Door Restoration Program, the refinishing of the exterior and interior doors and windows and the varnishing of the Church Pews. The painting of the church floor under the pews now stands out as a necessary project to complete.
