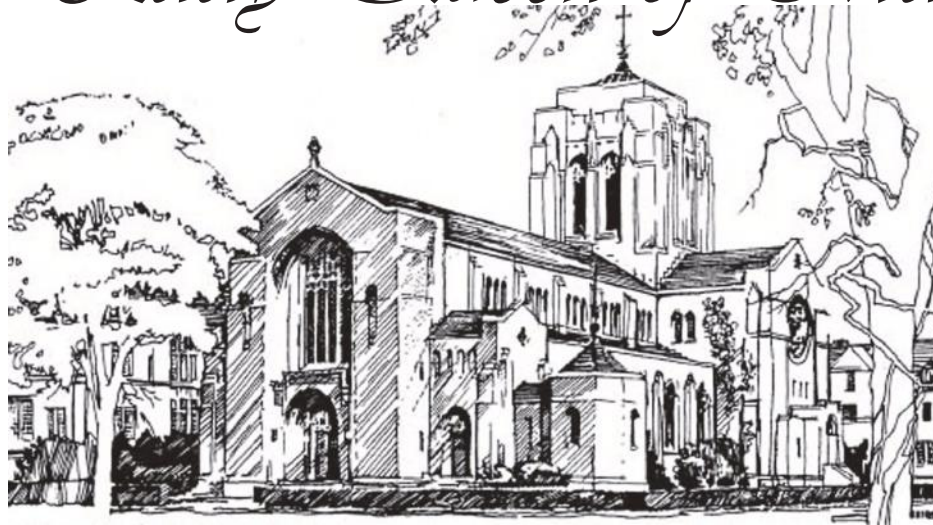

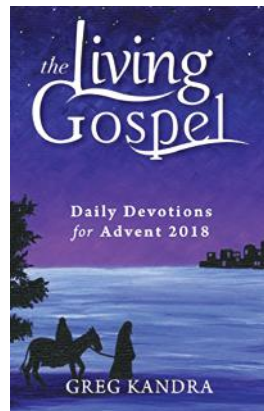


Daily Devotions for Advent

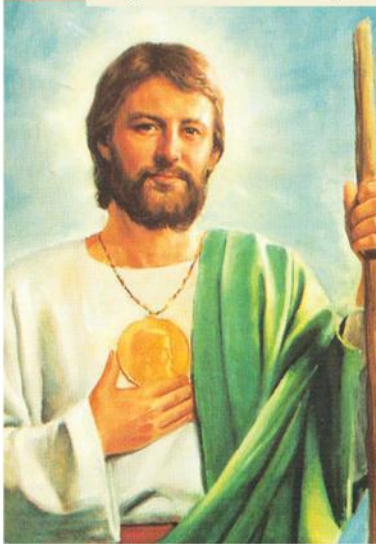

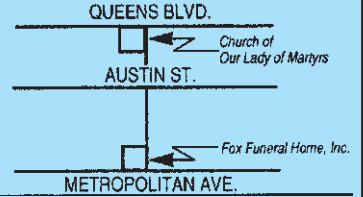
