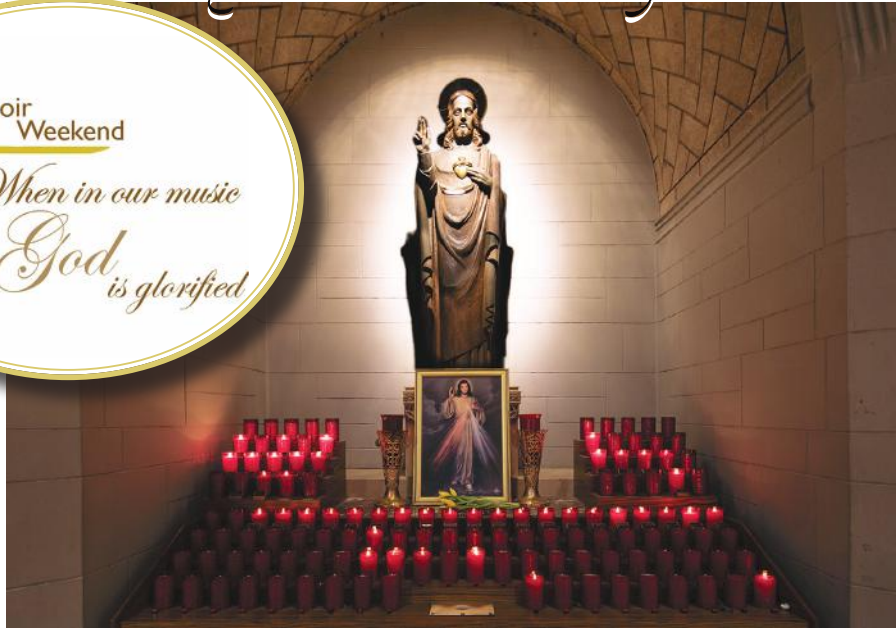

## **This Week's Reflection** from Catholic Social Teaching

### **Respect for Life Month: Focus on Healing**

*We are not the sum of our weaknesses and failures; we are the sum of the Father's love for us and our real capacity to become the image of his Son. (Pope St. John Paul II, July 28, 2002)*

**REFLECT:** “During his public life Jesus not only forgave sins, but also made plain the effect of this forgiveness: he reintegrated forgiven sinners into the community of the People of God from which sin had alienated or even excluded them. A remarkable sign of this is the fact that Jesus receives sinners at his table, a gesture that expresses in an astonishing way both God’s forgiveness and the return to the bosom of the People of God.... Christ has willed that in her prayer and life and action his whole Church should be the sign and instrument of the forgiveness and reconciliation that he acquired for us at the price of his blood.” (Catechism)

“Post-traumatic suffering is the untold story of abortion. Although the very real and frighteningly devastating phenomenon of post-abortion syndrome has been reported by those who suffer, until very recently nearly all medical and psychological health care professionals, and the academic groups that represent them, have ignored the human suffering associated with the practice of abortion. There are literally millions of women and men who, alone and abandoned, suffer some of the most serious psychological and spiritual consequences of abortion.” (Archdiocese of NY, <https://bit.ly/2YheAuM>)



# Special All Souls' Remembrances for the Month of November

In the Apostles Creed we pray: "I believe in the communion of saints." The word *communion* means a "sharing" and also "communication." Both meanings are part of the communion of saints. The word *saints* in the Creed does not just mean the saints in heaven. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us in paragraph 946: "That includes people who have died but have gone to purgatory and that includes the people who are still alive." *It includes us!*

We are trying to become saints and we are already part of the communion of saints. The Church has terms that identify the three different groups of souls who are part of the communion of saints. We call those who are already in heaven the "Church triumphant." Those who are waiting in purgatory are called the "Church suffering," and we who are still alive on earth are called the "Church militant."

Here at Our Lady Queen of Martyrs, we try in our special way during the year and especially in November to remember the souls of our faithfully departed brothers and sisters whose funerals were celebrated here. We will be remembering our dearly departed brothers and sisters who we buried here during the last five years through a reading of their names, in alphabetical order, at the Masses starting on November 2, All Souls' Day.

Active members of our community through their annual almsgiving have remembered the souls of their loved ones in an individual way through their participation in the memorial candles at the Sacred Heart of Jesus altar.
