

# This Week's Reflection

from Catholic Teaching



### Marriage and the Holy Eucharist

"The Eucharist is the very source of Christian marriage." (Pope St. John Paul II)

**REFLECT:** God who created us out of love also calls us to love. We are "the only creatures on earth that God has willed for [our] own sake, and [we] alone are called to share, by knowledge and love, in God's own life.... This is the fundamental and innate vocation of every human being. For man is created in the image and likeness of God who is himself love. Since God created him man and woman, their mutual love becomes an image of the absolute and unfailing love with which God loves man" (Catechism).

Pope Benedict XVI: "Marriage based on exclusive and definitive love becomes the icon of the relationship between God and his people and vice versa. God's way of loving becomes the measure of human love." Pope St. John Paul II reminds us that God's love, as seen in Jesus' Paschal Sacrifice, is one of total self-giving, and we, made in God's image, only find ourselves truly human in acts of self-giving. In marriage, this self-giving is mutual and total; it is covenantal and Eucharistic.

Pope Benedict XVI: "The Eucharist draws us into Jesus' act of self-oblation ... we enter into the very dynamic of his self-giving. The imagery of marriage between God and Israel is now realized in a way previously inconceivable: it had meant standing in God's presence, but now it becomes union with God through sharing in Jesus' self-gift, sharing in his body and blood."

Pope St. John Paul II: "The Eucharist is the very source of Christian marriage. The Eucharistic Sacrifice, in fact, represents Christ's covenant of love with the Church, sealed with His blood on the Cross. In this sacrifice of the New and Eternal Covenant, Christian spouses encounter the source from which their own marriage covenant flows, is interiorly structured and continuously renewed."

**DO:** If you are married or contemplating marriage, worthily receive the Eucharist and ask Christ to form you as self-gift for your beloved.
