Our Parish Hymn on Our Feast Day

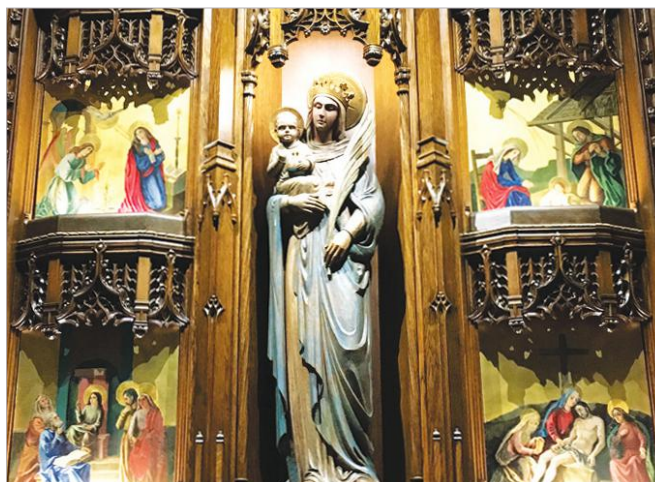
Our Lady, Queen of Martyrs, O flower from above, the Mother of Our Savior and the guardian of His love.

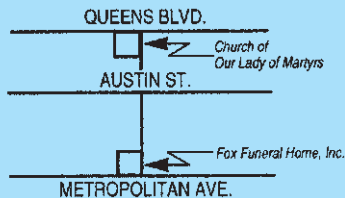
