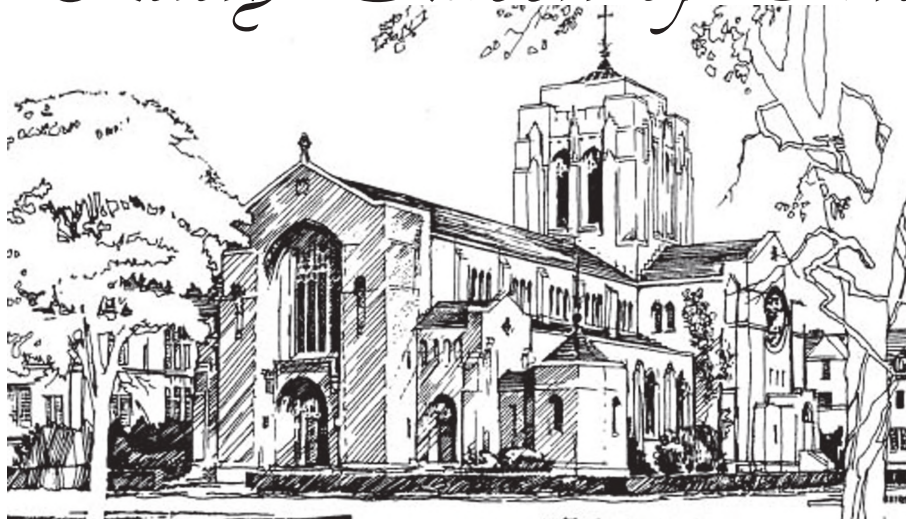

## A View from the Pew

### Praying for Vocations—and for Ourselves

As most know by now, Bishop DiMarzio has declared a “Year of Vocations” for the Diocese of Brooklyn—and here at Our Lady Queen of Martyrs, we will be doing our part across nine weeks this fall with a special Thursday evening Novena for Vocations, which began last week and continues through November 9.

Along with praying for vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, and religious life, and hearing from guest speakers who will share their faith stories, we’ll also be praying for one of the most overlooked vocations in our Church: marriage. Yes, **marriage**. Marriage is a vitally important vocation in its own right, and one of the sacramental treasures of our faith. (Christ himself signified its importance when he chose a wedding as the site of his first miracle—a miracle of transformation and generous love that in many ways mirrors marriage itself.)

To be honest, without committed Catholic husbands and wives, mothers and fathers, we wouldn’t have any of those other vocations! Indeed, virtually anyone who enters religious life will tell you that the first stirrings of a vocation began at home, in the “domestic church”—where prayer and a love of the Lord are nurtured and encouraged and treasured.

But what if you don’t feel that God is calling you to a vocation?

Well, all the more reason to gather with us for this novena and pray. Because the simple fact remains: God is calling all of us, in some fashion. Every one of us has been created for something extraordinary. Each of us has a vocation—a mission to serve the Lord in ways we may not even realize. Pope Benedict put it beautifully:

*Each of you has a personal vocation which He has given you for your own joy and sanctity. When a person is conquered by the fire of His gaze, no sacrifice seems too great to follow Him and give Him the best of ourselves. This is what the saints have always done, spreading the light of the Lord ... and transforming the world into a welcoming home for everyone.*

I invite you, then, to join us for this wonderful opportunity to reflect, to pray, to share—and to spend some time in the presence of the Lord and (as a great hymn puts it) “ponder anew what the Almighty can do.”

Let me leave you with a beautiful Prayer for Vocations, from the U.S. bishops, dedicated to our patroness, the Blessed Mother.

*Hail Mary, full of grace; all generations call you blessed.*

*Hail Mother of God; when asked by the angel to bear the Son of the Most High, filled with faith, you responded: “Let it be done unto me.”*

*Holy Mother of Jesus, at the wedding feast at Cana, you prompted your Son to perform his first sign. Be with us as we discern our life’s work and guide us in the way we are called to follow in the footsteps of your Son.*

*Holy Mother of the Savior, at the foot of the cross you mourned the death of your only Son. Bless and embrace the loving parents of all priests, deacons, brothers and sisters.*

*Holy Mother of the Good Shepherd, turn your motherly care to this nation. Intercede for us to the Lord of the harvest to send more laborers to the harvest in this land dedicated to your honor.*

*Queen of Peace, Mirror of Justice, Health of the Sick, inspire vocations in our time.*

*Let the word of your Son be made flesh anew in the lives of persons anxious to proclaim the good news of everlasting life.*

*Amen.*

### Then and Now at OLQM

**From the church bulletin archives:** On New Year's Eve of 1939, when this church was newly built, the then-church organist, Mrs. Sharkey, gave a concert on the chimes. At midnight the chimes sounded the hour. Then, in welcome to the New Year, the chimes rang out with "Auld Lang Syne," "The Star and Stripes Forever," "The Notre Dame Victory March," "America the Beautiful," and the National Anthem. By the late 1950s the church's bells fell silent; the reason is somewhat of a mystery. Now after 60 years, we can hear them again daily.

**2017 Carillon Schedule:** The new electronic chimes sounding from the church bell tower play four times daily (9 a.m., noon, 3 p.m., 6 p.m.) and seven minutes before Sunday Masses.

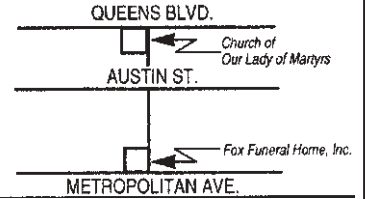
