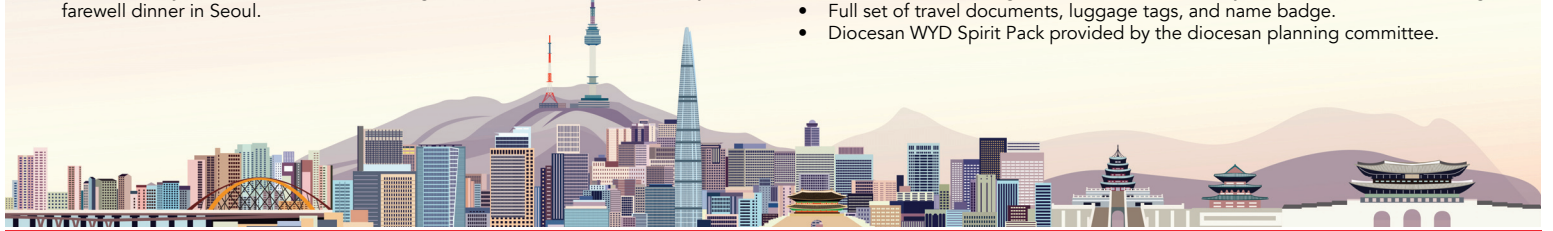

Day 1 Sunday, August 1: Depart for South Korea

Saturday, July 31 – late night check-in for our early morning outbound flight. We'll depart New York on our overseas pilgrimage to Seoul, South Korea, for the World Youth Day celebration. Complimentary dinner breakfast (B), snacks, and beverages will be served on board.

Day 2 Monday, August 2: Welcome to Seoul!

Early morning, arrive at Incheon International Airport, claim our luggage and a Peter's Way Tour Manager will meet us upon exiting Customs. Board our comfortable tour bus and we will be on our way to Seoul.

Celebrate Mass (location to be advised). Independent lunch.

Check-in at hotel (pick up WYD registration packets).

Dinner and overnight at hotel in Seoul.

Day 3 Tuesday, August 3: Seoul | WYD Opening Mass

Breakfast at our hotel. Morning touring schedule to be advised.

Independent lunch. This afternoon we'll participate in the **World Youth Day Opening Mass, presided over by His Eminence Lazarus You Heung-sik**, and concelebrated by bishops and priests from around the world.

Independent dinner with WYD meal pass.

Overnight at hotel in Seoul.

Day 4 Wednesday, August 4: Highlights of Seoul | Catechesis

Breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we'll have a **Catholic Heritage Tour** and introduction to Korean Catholic history. Begin with a visit to Myeong-dong Cathedral, a stunning Gothic cathedral, officially the Cathedral Church of the Virgin Mary of the Immaculate Conception, considered the birthplace of the Korean Catholic community. It holds the remains of many martyrs in its crypt and serves as a powerful symbol of faith and perseverance. Continue to Jeoldusan Martyrs' Shrine. Explore the shrine's grounds and the onsite Korean Catholic Martyrs' Museum, which houses historical artifacts, paintings, and sculptures related to the persecution and the lives of the martyrs. Additional sites to be advised.

World Youth Day participants will have opportunities to attend various catechesis sessions with participating bishops.

Free afternoon to participate in WYD activities. Independent dinner.

Day 5 Thursday, August 5: Catechesis | Papal Welcome & Festival

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, World Youth Day participants will have the opportunity to attend various catechesis sessions with participating bishops and **celebrate Holy Mass**. Participate in the ongoing WYD activities and enjoy more opportunities to meet your fellow pilgrims. This afternoon we will gather for the arrival of our Holy Father, Pope Leo XVI (location to be advised), hear his message of welcome and pray together! This will be one of the greatest experiences and memories of World Youth Day. Youth Festival activities continue throughout the evening.

Day 6 Friday, August 6, The Transfiguration: Morning Catechesis | Way of the Cross

Breakfast at our hotel. This morning, World Youth Day participants will have the opportunity to attend various catechesis sessions with participating bishops and **celebrate Holy Mass**. Independent lunch.

Our day concludes with **The Way of the Cross**. The World Youth Day Cross is carried in a procession during this service and together we will follow a designated route through the city, giving testimony to our faith.

We will be united with young people from all around the world as we meet the Crucified Christ in Seoul.

Day 7 Saturday, August 7: Pilgrimage Walk to Vigil Site | Prayer Vigil with Pope Leo

Breakfast at our hotel. Our hotel rooms will be secured for the evening, so pack appropriately for our overnight campout. We will **join the multitude of pilgrims on a walking pilgrimage to the vigil site**. Activities will include testimonies of young people, music, prayers to the Blessed Mother, etc., as we prepare for the Vigil.

This evening, **Pope Leo will address the youth of the world** and lead us in Adoration, Prayer and Benediction. Tonight's outdoor sleepover will be a great opportunity for us to share our faith and love for the Lord, and to think about new ways in which we can bring the Holy Father's message home to our friends and families. For those who so wish, there will be a space reserved for Adoration of The Blessed Sacrament.

Day 8 Sunday, August 8: Mass of Sending | Farewell Dinner

Boxed breakfast from hotel. This morning, **the Holy Father will concelebrate Mass** with thousands of bishops and priests, and he will address young people and those who are not so young, to send them out to the world as witnesses to the faith in imitation of Our Lady. At the end of the concluding Mass, the Holy Father will announce the place where the next World Youth Day meeting will be held. Receive Holy Communion in the presence of the Pope and carry Christ's love with you forever.

At the end of Mass, the Holy Father will announce the place where the next World Youth Day meeting will be held. This will be an experience you will never forget. Independent lunch.

This evening, we will celebrate these days by sharing a festive dinner with our Shepherd and group leaders.

Day 9 Monday, August 9: Return to the USA

Early breakfast at our hotel. Then, transfer to Incheon International Airport for our return flight to the USA (14-hour flight).

If paying with a credit card, the price is \$200 higher than the cash discounted price featured in this brochure. Peter's Way Tours (PWT) reserves the right to increase the package price or reduce services should there be an escalation in the Euro valuation over the U.S. Dollar in excess of 3% from print date. If a final payment is not received by the balance deadline, PWT reserves the right to cancel your reservation. A \$50.00 late fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for late payments. Personal checks will not be accepted within 30 days of departure. If the bank returns a personal check, a \$50.00 processing fee will apply and subsequent payments must be made in the form of money order, certified bank check, or debit/credit card. PWT collects funds on travelers' behalf and remits those funds to suppliers. PWT has no liability for suppliers' acts or omissions. By signing this enrollment form, you agree you will not initiate a chargeback against PWT for any supplier's failure to refund or provide credit due to a forced cancellation of services.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: All tour payments are non-refundable upon receipt. Travel insurance is recommended as protection for cancellations due to medical reasons (illness or injury). Travel insurance payments are non-refundable and non-transferable. Tour participation is non-transferable. Names cannot be changed on tour roster or airline tickets. All refund requests are subject to cancellation terms set forth above. Costs for tour services that are not utilized are non-refundable. We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance in order to protect your tour package investment. Please read all details very carefully under TRAVEL INSURANCE.

LATE RESERVATIONS: Enrollments received after the deposit deadline are subject to confirmation. Late fees and a possible increase in airfare may apply.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each traveler is solely responsible for carrying a valid passport and ascertaining knowledge of current entry/exit requirements for all countries on this itinerary. U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current international travel requirements. Beginning in January 2027, all visa-free visitors who were previously exempt must obtain a K-ETA before traveling to South Korea. Each traveler is solely responsible for ensuring that all required travel documents are complete and current. PWT will not be held responsible for a passenger's lack of current and valid entry documents (i.e., passport, proof of vaccine, any required test results).

AIR TRANSPORTATION: This travel package includes estimated round-trip economy class airfare from New York. Rates will be confirmed 11 months prior to departure. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Estimated departure taxes & fuel surcharges are subject to increase prior to ticketing.

AIRLINE SEATING: A group booking will be confirmed 11 months prior to departure. Under group contracts, seat selection is not permitted. Requests for seat preferences (window or aisle) may be made when you check in for the flight. There is no guarantee that requests will be honored. PWT cannot submit special seat requests on behalf of any passenger. Group reservations may not be accessed online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. If seat selection is a condition that affects your decision to travel, it is suggested that you purchase the land only package in order to book your airline arrangements according to your specific needs.

ACCOMMODATIONS: The package price is based on double occupancy (two twin beds). Triple rooms (two twin beds plus rollaway) may be requested, with no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms may be requested at time of booking. Single rooms are limited, subject to confirmation, may be smaller, and located apart from the room block. If a single room is confirmed, an additional charge of \$1,395 will apply.

MEALS: Breakfast daily at hotel (boxed breakfast August 8). Hotel dinner on arrival day and farewell dinner in Seoul. The WYD Registration fee (estimated at \$250 and subject to change) includes meal card/passes for meals as noted on the itinerary.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities and tips are included in your travel package (\$50 per person). All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included as well. Although service charges are included, it is customary to leave the equivalent of \$1.00 USD (1,500 South Korean won KRW) per person per day for housekeeping.

TRAVELER HEALTH ADVISORY: Passengers must be medically and physically fit for travel and ensure that such traveling will not endanger themselves or others. The WYD pilgrimage entails a lot of walking. Tour buses are not equipped with wheelchair ramps. A traveler who requires special assistance must notify PWT and must be accompanied by a travel companion who will provide proper help. PWT shall not be held responsible if we are unable to accommodate passengers with special needs. PWT is not responsible for the denial of services to any passenger by any carrier, hotel, restaurant, or other independent suppliers.

PWT offers an optional Passenger Travel Protection Plan. These benefits and services help ensure the well-being of the passenger while traveling worldwide.
